Congratulations on your interest in participating in Camp Tuku's Counselor in Training program! Through our CIT program we seek to mentor young adults with strong leadership capabilities and support them in finding their own unique voice and leadership style.

As a CIT you will be asked to assist with the implementation of camp activities, provide secondary support for campers in your assigned bunk areas, assist with guiding younger campers around camp, and assist with evening activities. Additionally, CITs may assist with other tasks as delegated by the Director of Operations and other leadership staff.

In addition to these responsibilities, CITs have a very unique opportunity to participate in leadership workshops to gain a better understanding of themselves and their leadership abilities.

CITs must be available for camp for the duration of both sessions and should anticipate arriving at camp on June 17th.

Pre-camp Orientation: June 17th - June 18th, 2021

Session 1: June 19 - June 25, 2022 Session 2: June 26 - July 2, 2022

Tuition: \$450/week

Qualifications: Must be between the ages of 15-17. Must have a positive attitude, excellent communication skills, passion for working with children, strong leadership abilities, ability to be self-reflective. Background check will be required. CPR/First Aid Certification preferred.
