### Our Ideal Candidate:

Our ideal candidate for this position has experience running athletic programs in an outdoor recreation setting & the ability to inspire and motivate junior staff to implement engaging recreational programs with youth.

In addition to executing daily programming the Athletics Director will mentor, supervise, and manage speciality counselors within their department. Ideally you are First Aid and CPR certified & have a passion for experiential learning experiences!

### Description of the Role:

#### **Program Planning**

- Develop and implement a comprehensive athletic program that caters to the age, interests, and abilities of campers.
- Create a schedule of sports and athletic activities throughout the camp session & support evening programming as necessary.

#### **Staff Supervision**

- Supervise speciality counselors within the umbrella of the Athletics department & assigned cabin counselors; providing mentorship & valuable feedback to help junior staff support campers in all aspects of camp life.
- Conduct staff meetings & training sessions as needed within the scope of the department.

#### **Equipment and Facilities**

- Responsible for the management of athletic equipment & facilities at camp including ensuring equipment/facilities are safe, well-maintained, and in good working order.

#### **Safety & First Aid**

- Ensure safety procedures are being followed in the implementation of athletic programs.

#### **Communication**

- Maintain open and clear communication with camp leadership, staff, and campers.

#### **Emergency Response**

- Be prepared for emergencies at camp & coordinate with camp leadership to respond appropriately to emergency situations.

**Requirements:** Experience supporting Athletic operations in a camp setting. Experience working with children. Background Check. CPR/First Aid certification preferred.
