Description of the role:

Our Healthcare Provider's primary responsibility is to oversee the health & safety of our campers and staff.

Responsibilities

- 1. Provide health care to meet the individual needs of camp staff and campers.
- 2. Handle health emergencies and injuries, including emergency preparedness and provisions for professional healthcare.
- 3. Deliver and administer medications to campers and staff according to the schedule on file.
- 4. Maintain accurate and detailed medical records according to state and American Camp Association Standards.
 - a. Prepare and utilize daily medical log for treatment and medications.
 - b. Prepare and record insurance and accident report forms.
 - c. Report required incidents to the local health department within 24 hours.
- 5. Oversee first Aid procedures and supplies.
 - a. Inventory and order all necessary medical supplies and equipment.
 - b. Prepare and distribute first aid kits throughout camp including camp vehicles, kitchen, offices, waterfront, activity areas, and out-of-camp trips.
- 6. Ensure a staff orientation session is delivered on medical services.
 - a. Ensure camp staff and campers know their role related to health care and first aid.
- 7. Screen all campers and staff who are arriving and departing camp.
 - a. Verify health history. Examination, and emergency authorization
 - b. Identify any observable evidence of illness or communicable diseases.
 - c. Keep all medications used by campers and staff.
